



Relationship	Definition of Eligible Dependents	Required Document(s)
Spouse	Your legal spouse	 TWO documents must be provided. A copy of your marriage certificate; or Certificate of Informal Marriage AND One of the following: A copy of the front page of your most current federal tax return confirming this dependent is your spouse A document* showing joint ownership status such as a recurring monthly household bill or statement of account. The document must list both of your names and a recent date in the past 60 days. A document* showing your spouse's current residency such as a recurring household bill or statement of account. The document must list your spouse's name, your mailing address, and a recent date in the past 60 days. *Healthcare bills will not be accepted as proof of eligibility as healthcare coverage is being verified.
Child	Children up to age 26: Your biological children Your step-children Your adopted children (as of the date the child is "placed for adoption," which means the assumption and retention of a legal obligation for total or partial support of a child in anticipation of adoption of the child) Any children for whom you are responsible under court order *Coverage can be extended to children age 26 or older, if they are primarily supported by you or your spouse and are incapable of selfsustaining employment by reason of mental or physical handicap. The dependent must have become incapable of self-support before age 26.	ONE document must be provided. • A copy of the child's birth certificate/hospital birth record or adoption certificate naming you or your spouse/partner** as the child's parent. Please note the document must list the first and last names of the child and parent(s). OR • A copy of the court order naming you or your spouse/partner** as the child's legal guardian. **Note for a stepchild: If you are covering a stepchild you must also provide documentation of your current relationship to your spouse as requested above.
